Invoice Adjustments

SMMware invoices can now have multiple adjustments, making it easier to be clear when more than one adjustment is involved, for example when you need to deduct more than one customer payment. The issue with the invoice at QBO not reflecting the adjustments upon copying is also resolved.

Settings Editor

The Settings Editor has been updated to allow you to self manage the following:

Job Types

You can add or rename Job Types. If the Job Type is not in use, you can delete it.

The Categories used for Organizations and Contacts

You can add or rename Categories. If the Category is not in use, you can delete it.

Custom Fields for Jobs

Can rename and re-order, can show/hide rows of 4 fields.

Custom Fields for Clients

Can rename and re-order, can show/hide rows of 4 fields.

Custom Fields for Associates

Can rename and re-order, can show/hide rows of 4 fields.

Customizing Keys for the Sales Statusboard and the Ops Statusboard

Can add, rename, and delete keys.
