### New Homepage Section, 'My Invites, Upcoming Events'

For those of you whose events manage attendees using Invites (as opposed to 'Direct' or 'Availability'), SMMware now offers a homepage section called 'My Invites, Upcoming Events'.

There you will find a list of events that you have been invited to, and can choose 'Request' to say that you would like to be a part of that event, or 'Decline' to say that you would not.

This works the same way as the links in the invite emails, and is meant for those occasions when someone misplaces their invite email.

By default, this section is hidden, but you can activate it from the Settings Editor. Go to Admin->Settings and edit Section 4) Calendar. The setting is called "Homepage section 'My Invites, Upcoming Events'".

Note that each time someone responds, the main contact gets an email just as when an Associate clicks on a link in an invite email. So Associates should be deliberate when they click on these links. If they change their mind a number of times, the main contact will get a number of extra emails.

## **Next**

We are continuing work on supporting multiple pay rates for employees. Unfortunately, upon detailed investigation, the QuickBooks Online interface does not in fact allow SMMware to specify a pay level, but the SMMware Payroll/Expense/Travel report will reflect them, as will the Profitability Report.
