If you are not familiar with them, QR codes are a kind of bar code, meant to be read by a computer.

Hours Entries: Presets for Description

Now, when you click on a preset for the descriptions of hours entries, the new preset is added to the existing description instead of replacing it.

There have been occasional requests for this change over time, and we decided it would be appropriate to put in place.

The Return of 'History Of Hourly Rates'

At the bottom of a given Associate Profile, a History of Hourly Rates has been brought back in a slightly different form.

It now lists the Pay Levels that the associate has been paid at, and for each pay level breaks out a sub-list of rates the Associate has been paid for that Pay Level. For each rate, it shows the last date the rate was paid, and the total number of hours that rate was paid.

If you don't enter custom pay rates for hourly entries, the result will be very simple and much the same as the previous History.

But if you follow more complex rules and enter custom pay rates for various hourly entries, while the result will also be more complex, it will provide the clearest picture of what rates you have paid in the past.
